Course Objectives	The primary goal of this course is for the student to upgrade his theoretical knowledge in the field of obligation relations in the field of damages law, ie to gain expanded knowledge about the types of responsibilities, the consequences of the damage caused and the like. By mastering this scientific discipline which is an integral part of the law of obligations, the student will gain skills and knowledge for clear and unambiguous distinction of material from non-material damage, as well as to recognize the motives of the perpetrator for causing it.
Course Contents	Within this course program, the subject of study will be the issue related to causing damage and the rights and obligations arising from this action. Special attention will be paid to the types of liabilities and practical cases of liability for damages. The subject of study will be the causes of damage and their economic motive. Cases from practice will be illustrated in which it will be possible to more vividly distinguish tangible from non-tangible damage. Attention will also be paid to the responsibility for the perpetrator of the damage.
